### Theaters of Shakespeare's Time.

London still possesses two buildings where plays of Shakespeare were produced in the poet's lifetime. In the hall of Gray's Inn "A Comedy of Errors" was performed in 1594 as part of the grand night revels, when the audience was so numerous that there was no room for the players until some of the guests had withdrawn in disgust. And in the Middle Temple hall, opened by Queen Elizabeth in person in 1576, "Twelfth Night" was played in 1602, also as part of the revels for which the Inns of Court were so famous that old dictionaries defined revels as "noisy pastimes used at Inns of Court."

### Founded on Herring Bones.

Dutch monopoly of the North sea fishing grounds during the seventeenth century brought such wealth and prosperity to Amsterdam that the capital of Holland was popularly said to be founded on herring bones. No fewer than 50,000 Hollanders were directly engaged in fishing the coasts from near Yarmouth to as far north as the Netherlands, and 150,000 more were employed indirectly in the distribution and sale of the fish. Sir Walter Raleigh alluded to James I. how the Dutch had to the Yarmouth herring monopoly caught in their own nets for English gold, with which they built up a thousand ships and fishing boats.
