They are hymenoptera, and *Pepsis ornata* is a typical insect of this kind. They usually come upon the spiders when the latter are unprepared and sting them to death. A spider after being stung once has generally sufficient strength to hide in a tuft of grass, but his shelter proves only of temporary service, for the pitiless fly soon returns and completes its work by stinging the helpless victim twice in the lower part of the thorax.—Exchange.

The Greatest Singer.

Probably the most remarkable singer of all time was Farinelli, the beauty of whose soprano voice remains unequalled. His debut at seventeen at Rome in 1722 was extraordinary from his competing with a trumpet player in sustaining and swelling a note of astonishing length and power. For fifteen years he traveled extensively, and he reached Spain in 1737, intending to stay a few months, but remaining twenty-five years.
