70,000 TOWN LOTS IN COOS

**Assessor Thrift Finds Large
Amount of City Property
in Old Coos County.**

Assessor Thrift, who is just completing the compilation of statistics of the taxable property in Coos county, announces that the tax rolls show a total of 70,000 town lots laid out in the various town sites of Coos county. Many of these are found in the many additions to Marshfield North Bend and Bandon that were platted and placed on the market during one of the railroad boom periods. Some of these lots carry a very small assessment and in some cases the taxes are scarcely sufficient to pay for the clerical work in keeping the records, but they must be carried on the books according to the original plats.—Coos Bay Times.

CIRCUIT COURT SESSION

Frank Cameron, who formerly ran the Agitator in Marshfield, was found guilty by a jury in Circuit Court of bootlegging. The jury was out only a little while. Cameron was indicted last Fall for illegally selling liquor on South Slough. Tom Bennett and J. M. Upton defended him. It was intimated that his attorneys may appeal the case and Judge Coke fixed the date of sentence as May 2. Cameron will probably furnish bond meanwhile.

Edmunds, the forger from Marshfield, whom Sheriff Gage captured at Price, Utah, entered a plea of guilty to the indictment charging forgery. He was about to plead guilty to a second indictment charging him with obtaining money under

false pretenses, but Tom Hall, his attorney, instructed him not to. His trial on the latter charge was set for tomorrow morning.

Winkler, the half-breed Indian of Bandon, who was indicted for attempting to assault a nine-year-old girl, will be tried this week.

The date of the trial of J. S. Barton indicted for attempted assault on Miss Madge Yoakam, has not been fixed.

Canadian Farmers Com- to the United States

Thousands of American farmers have been going to Canada within the last few years, and now it begins to look as if Canadian farmers were anxious to secure property in the milder climate of the Pacific coast states. The Portland Telegram of the 25th says that Willamette Valley and Southern Oregon may receive an increased population of fully 10,000 thrifty people through one single exodus of farmers from Canada alone, in the next year or two. A delegation of four well-to-do land owners of Saskatchewan Province is conducting a quite investigation of the Willamette, Umpqua and Rogue River valleys, as the representatives of more than 3500 Canadian farmers who are desirous of joining one vast immigrative movement to Oregon. The moving cause in bringing the Saskatchewan down here is the hard and severe struggle they have had against the inhospitable climate of the North, the short seasons and the narrow limits to the character of the crops that can be raised.
