New Law.

It will be unlawful in this state to employ girls under 18 years of age for more than eight hours and twenty minutes a day or 50 hours per week. This law will go into effect October 4, 1913. It will be unlawful to keep a girl under 18 employed after 6 p. m. or to pay a girl from 16 to 18 less than \$1.00 per day, except in cases of apprentices. The law provides that any employer who shall violate the ruling of the commission shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100, or imprisonment in the county jail for not less than 10 days nor more than three months, or both fine and imprisonment.

Biggest Price For Ty Cobb

Detroit, Aug. 24.—Manager Griffith, of the Washington American League Baseball team, announced today that he is authorized to offer \$100,000 to the owners of the Detroit Club for Ty Cobb, and is confident that the offer will be accepted. Griffith and President Navin, of the Detroit team will confer this afternoon. This far the highest price on record ever offered for a baseball player.

Rules of Labor Commissioner

Slashers—All guards on slasher saws must be continuous so as to cover the entire series of saws; the guard to be made solid and to extend beyond the edge of the saw at least 24 inches, and the height from the platform to be not over an inch above the arbor line.

Boilers—1. All horizontal tubular boilers must have fusible plugs, placed in rear tube sheet at least 2 1/2 inches above top row of flues. 2. All fire box boilers must have fusible plugs, to be placed at the highest point of crown sheet.

3. All safety valves must be examined frequently and kept in good working condition.

4. All boilers must be provided with three water gauge cocks.

5. All boilers must have blow off connection at the bottom of the back end or lowest point of boiler.

6. All water glasses on boilers

must be properly guarded. Spike Rolls—Spike live rolls used for conveying lumber in the mills or yards must be discontinued.

Linotype and monotype machines—All metal parts on linotype and monotype machines must be piped so as to carry vapor out of room.—O. P. Hoff, Commissioner.

Anvil Coming Back.

A Portland paper says: "Thoroughly overhauled and presenting the appearance of a brand new craft the gasoline schooner Anvil, which went ashore near the mouth of the Nehalem early in April, will go in commission again on her old route as soon as an engineer, who has been employed, arrives from San Francisco. William Blissner, formerly in charge of her engine rooms, resigned his position on account of illness.

"Captain George Tyler has accepted a berth as master of the Anvil.

"Officials of the Oregon Shore Navigation Company say that the Anvil will provide a weekly service, clearing from this end of the line every Saturday. She has accommodations for 40 passengers and capacity for taking care of 300 tons of general freight at each trip. She will call regularly at Florence, Bandon and Newport.
