INFORMATION TO SETTLERS

ROSEBURG LAND OFFICE ISSUES CIRCULAR DESCRIBING LAND RECENTLY OPENED FOR SETTLEMENT.

Roseburg, Ore., May 17.—The following information to settlers has been issued by the United States land office here:

By proclamation of the President dated May 4, the following area were excluded from the Siskiyou National Forest, in Oregon, and the vacant lands embraced therein will be subject to settlement only under the homestead laws from and including 9 o'clock a. m., standard time, Jan 29, 1914, until and including July 21, 1914, but thereafter they will be subject to entry and disposition under an and all of the public land laws applicable thereto:

In township 30, Range 13—Sections 5 to 8 inclusive; Sections 17, 18, 2 and 21; and Sections 26 to 35 inclusive.

In Township 31, Range 13—Sections 2 to 6 inclusive, and Sections 8 and 9.

In township 31, Range 14—Sections 7 to 11 inclusive; sections 18 to 21 inclusive, and Sections 26 to 34 inclusive.

Section 6 and N½ and SW¼ of Section 7, Township 30, Range 13, are unsurveyed.

Unsurveyed lands will be open to settlement only on June 29; they will not be open to entry or for filing until the plat of survey is filed in this office. Settlers on such unsurveyed lands prior to this withdrawal who have continued to comply with the homestead laws will not be affected by this proclamation.

Warning is expressly given that all persons who have gone upon any of the above described lands and performed any act of settlement on or since the date of proclamation (May 4, 1914), or who shall go thereon and perform any act of settlement before 9 o'clock, a. m., standard time, June 29, 1914, or who are on or occupying any portion of said lands at such hour, will be considered and dealt with as trespassers, and preference will be given the first legal applicant notwithstanding such unlawful settlement or occupancy. However,

there is nothing in the proclamation to prevent persons from going upon and over the said lands to examine them with a view to thereafter going upon and making settlement thereon when the land shall become subject thereto as aforesaid.

Intending settlers should ascertain the status of the unsurveyed portion of these lands, as settlements may have been made thereon before the Forest Reserve was created; and, also, they should get all information available as to the surveyed land, by inquiry at this office, or otherwise, before making settlement of tendering filings thereon, as a considerable portion of it was entered before the Reserve was created, and will not, therefore, be subject to settlement or entry.

Filings will be received at this office on and after 9 o'clock a. m., of July 27, 1914, and all applications presented here before that time will be rejected. Applications must be executed before a U. S. Commissioner or the County Clerk of the County where the land is situated, before said date, but these must not be filed in this office before July 27, or they, also, will be rejected.

The records of this office showing the vacant lands are open to inspection, and diagrams showing them will be furnished; but as each diagram covers only one township, care should be used when ordering to give the number thereof, and the number of the range also. Only lawful money, postal money order or certified check will be accepted in payment.

Copies of the homestead laws, as well as "Suggestions to Homesteaders," may be had on request.

Sunday night workmen on the dredge Seattle were horrified to find a human form protruding from the mouth of the great auger intake pipe, when it was shifted to ascertain the cause of its refusal to work.
