PORT ORFORD NEWS

From the Tribune:

A move is on foot to take the matter up with the County Court of building a wagon road up Sixes River to connect with the railroad C. A. Smith is building to Eckley. There is also a good wagon road at Eckley leading to Myrtle Point.

Ed. Gallier and Mr. Button, of Bandon, spent several days in Port Orford since our last issue. These gentlemen both believe in the future of this section, and if our people meet them half way in their efforts to advance the interests of northern Curry county it will probably result in the investment of capital that will mean much to the county.

P. J. Lindberg is in receipt of a letter of inquiry relative to one, Samuel Curry, an old California, who a number of years ago worked the Granite Peak ledge tunnel near Salmon mountain in this county. Any information of what became of Mr. Curry would be gratefully received by his son, J. A. Curry, of Myton, Utah.

Salmon are striking the troll both on Elk and Sixes river, and excellent fishing with hook and line for salmon trout is reported on these streams.

The steamer Mayfair was to have called here last week for a load of railroad ties, but the southerly wind that was blowing frightened her away. She will stop here on her return trip.

Mr. and Mrs. John R. Miller started for California Sunday. They drove their Ford auto to Bandon from whence they will ship the machine and take passage by steamer for San Francisco. They expect to spend several months visiting slowly south along the California coast, and will reach San Diego some time in the spring where they may locate. Mr. Miller still holds his property at Port Orford and it is not unlikely that he and Mrs. Miller will return to Curry at some future time.

During the past few days the shingle mill has been cutting a special order of shingles, with which a new roof will be put on the cold storage plant. This building which now belongs to R. L. Macleay, was selected by E. D. Hume at a cost of \$35,000 for the purpose of developing the deep sea fishing industry at this place. Shortly after the plant was completed Mr. Hume died, and as a consequence it has never been used other than for a storage room.

Rev. H. M. Myers and wife arrived in Port Orford last week from Portland, and will make their home here for the coming year at least. The late Methodist conference stationed Rev. Myers at this place to fill the vacancy caused by Rev. Paul's departure. Mr. Myers is an earnest and entertaining speaker and he and Mrs. Myers are sociable, hospitable people, and will be gladly welcomed in our midst.
