The records are accepted by dairymen everywhere as being correct and authenic, and if any cow fails to measure up to standard dairy requirements, she is put out of the class of profitable dairy cows and her place in the herd will be supplied by another and better cow. In this way good cows are secured for the present production, and still better cows will be bred for future producers.
