Wednesday the 21st day of April 1915, for the purchase of street improvement bonds to the amount of \$8,195.45 all of said bonds to be in denominations not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00. They bear interest at the rate of 5 per cent per annum from

date thereof payable semi-annually. Said bonds are dated January 1st, 1915, and mature in ten years thereon after with prepayment option thereon at face value and accrued interest to date of any semi-annual coupon interest period after one year from date of bonds. Said bonds are authorized by the laws of the State of Oregon and Ordinances of the Common Council of the City of Bandon, Oregon.
