There is nothing to prevent the average mountain rancher from realizing a handsome fortune on his strawberry crop. There is not a single ranch in the mountain section east of town that is not capable of marketing from \$250 to \$1000 worth of strawberries each season. The soil of that locality is peculiarly adapted to strawberry culture. The entire surface of the soil is completely covered with the growth of the wild strawberry plant, which fact alone is worthy of note in demonstrating what success awaits anyone in the culture of the tame varieties. However, this is but mere secondary evidence when compared with the results gained by the few farmers who have given the berry crop attention. While not so early in market as the Hood River and Milton production, the Blue Mountain berry is far superior in size, flavor and quality than comparison is out of question entirely. The mountain berry, owing to its natural maturity without the disqualifying aid of irrigation, retains a vigor and firmness that is always absent in the irrigated fruit. The berries raised by mountain farmers find ready sale in the nearby town and advance prices paid for berries with the irrigated pedigree. The only trouble found with the mountain berries is, there are not enough to supply the demand. This is the fault of the producers. The demand awaits the action of the mountain rancher, and he should give this demand his earnest attention. It means dollars to him. Home consumption is not the only call that he would have to heed, for no sooner than the merit of his berries is known, than big cities would be clamoring for their share. Hood River and Milton do not begin to supply the demand, and besides, those who are sure to find a good thing, would always wait for the Blue Mountain berries. The mountain ranches in this respect are in a favored section, and there is virtually no reason whatever that the section cannot become famous in the production of strawberries. Berries in ear-load lots, as what did it for California, Hood River and Milton. It will do it for the Blue Mountain section. It is now up to the mountain ranchers.

In view of the fact that frauds of a similar nature have been perpetrated before, notably in the Chicago elevator case, it is astonishing that the banks should have allowed such large sums of money to flow out on such flimsy security.

There is no excuse for tipping in the United States and workmen who accept tips do injury to themselves.
