The connection of the Philippines with the United States with submarine cable will prove of inestimable value to this country as well as a great saving in the expense of sending official messages. During the Spanish-American war and the subsequent revolution in the islands a vast sum of money was expended by this country for cable dispatches, a condition which would be greatly minimized in the future as well as creating a much lower rate on commercial and official business in time of peace, says the Walla Walla Union. 


