

WILL CONVICT THEM

HENEY SAYS HE POSSESSES
SOME STRONG EVIDENCE.

He May Also Show That Prominent
and Wealthy Men are Guilty
of Great Fraud.

Francis J. Heney, who resigned as representative of the attorney general, was appointed to the place of United States Attorney Hall. In speaking of the Oregon land frauds he said:

"The extent of the land frauds in Oregon is far greater than I imagined, even after I learned the extent of the Hydro-Benson frauds through my connection with the prosecuting of that case. Oregon is under the domination of a corrupt political ring, which hesitates at nothing to accomplish its ends. Hundreds of thousands of acres of the finest timber lands in the world have been secured from the United States during the past few years by half a dozen individuals through fraud, perjury and subordination of perjury. The good people of Oregon will be as much astounded when they hear the evidence in the case against Senator Mitchell and Congressman Hermann as they were when they heard the evidence in the case of Puter, McKinley and others, which has already been tried, and in which the defendants were convicted. The case against Hermann and Mitchell does not depend in the slightest degree upon the testimony of Puter and McKinley. The evidence is sufficient to warrant and sustain a conviction without placing either of them upon the stand as witnesses.

"The indictments already procured touch only the edge of the vast frauds which have been perpetrated in Oregon. The grand jury and I have fully a month of work ahead of us, and I expect to procure the indictment of at least a dozen wealthy and prominent persons who have profited most by these frauds. It may become necessary for me to request the removal of certain other federal officers in Oregon before we complete our investigation, but I recognize the grave responsibility which rests upon me in making such requests and am proceeding with the utmost caution and will not expect the president to act until I am in possession of unimpeachable evidence of improper conduct.

"As the representative of the attorney general, I deemed it best for the interests of the government, after having observed the actions of Hall, to recommend his immediate removal. My recommendation to that effect was wired to Washington Friday night and the president acted Saturday morning.

"In the meantime I had resigned as special representative of the attorney general, and was appointed United States attorney in Hall's place, to carry out my plans for the prosecution, which will be made known in due time."

BONDS OWNED AT HOME.

United States Securities Are for the
Most Part in the Possession
of Our Own People.

Probably fewer United States bonds are owned outside of the country than those of any other first-class nation in the world. This is largely accounted for by the fact that the bonds have a peculiar value to the national banks as a basis for circulation which raises their market price to a point where they cease to be desirable for ordinary investors. The total of bonds held by foreigners today is \$15,055,750, says the New York Post. Of this amount individuals own less than \$4,000,000; the rest being to foreign insurance companies doing business in the United States. Before a foreign insurance company can do business in the United States it must deposit with the insurance commissioner of the particular state it seeks to invade a certain amount of bonds, registered in the name of the insurance commissioner for the benefit of the policy holders of the company in that state. Thus, if the Phoenix Insurance company, of London, England, desires to do business in Ohio it deposits with the insurance commissioner an amount of bonds determined by the value of business, inscribed as follows: "The insurance commissioner of the state of Ohio, in trust for the policy holders of the Phoenix Insurance company of London, England, residing in Ohio." Of the individual foreign holdings of United States bonds nearly half of them, for some reason, are in Cuba. Our neighbors are doubtless attracted by the security which the bond offers.

In the earlier stages of the country's history large blocks of its bonds were held abroad and branches of the treasury department were opened in London for their transfer and exchange. The French people to-day are great holders of the bonds of various other nations, but they are handling very few of the United States. Quite a part of the loan made by the last Cleveland administration went into the hands of foreign investors at an early date in its history. But with the increasing means of the American people and the growing demand of the national banks, these securities have begun to come back, until now the world may be searched almost in vain for them.

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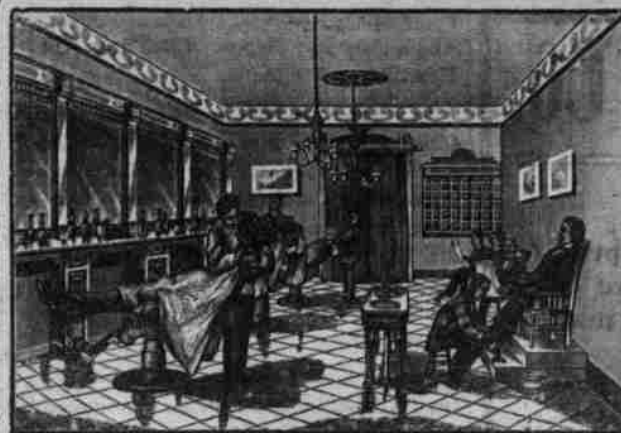
