More than thirty national conventions are scheduled to convene in Portland during the Lewis and Clark exposition. Electricity in its every conceivable application, representing the most marvelous achievements in modern science, may be seen at the Lewis and Clark exposition.

A native Filipino theatre, in which amusements peculiar to the inhabitants of our island territory, will be presented, is to be one of the many excellent attractions of the "Trail."

The government fisheries exhibit at the Lewis and Clark exposition will show the evolution of a Royal Chinook salmon, from the embryo to a well matured fish.

Some idea of the privations endured by Lewis and Clark in their expedition to the great Northwest, may be gleaned by a careful examination of the exhibits characteristic of the earlier history of Oregon territory.

The model dairy farm at the Lewis and Clark exposition in which everything pertaining to scientific dairying methods, the result of recent agricultural research, is to be shown, will prove of particular interest to those interested in dairying.

The caressing melody of the chimes in the towers of the main government building, will recall mental pictures of the missions founded by Junipero Serra and his intrepid followers in the 17th century.

But seldom are some of us afforded an opportunity to hear the world's famous bands. Many of them have been engaged to play at the fair, among them being Junes', De Caprio's, Ellery's and the Hawaiian Imperial band.

Williams was attorney general from 1871 to 1875.
