

INSPECTOR EVANS AFTER THE RUSSIAN THISTLE.

County Commissioners Should Realize Importance of Eradicating the Pest.

Howard Evans, recently appointed fruit inspector for Umatilla county, is calling attention to the Russian thistle, which has already obtained considerable footbold in this county. He warns the farmers of its destruct-

This obnoxious weed is very plentiful in the Hudson Bay district, where it is found along the roads and fined to a limited area in the county, and if the county commissioners realize in time the great importance of its total eradication it may be stamped out now and forever.

It is closely related to the American tumble weed, and is an annual coming from seed each year. Making its appearance in April and May, the first two leaves are tender shoots, resemstages are young and tender and are eaten by stock. It blossoms when two months old, and then increases in a dense, bushy mass from two to three feet high and from four to six feet in diameter, every branch being lined its entire length with seed. Under wind pressure it snaps off and bounds before the wind, distributing the seed in every direction, until stopped by a fence, ditch or vegetation, having scattered its seed over miles of territory. It takes complete possession of the land, crowding out other plants.

Mr. Evans holds that it is criminal to allow it to become established in this county and state, and calls on the farmers and county commissioners to take precaution against its spread in Umatilla county.
