# TAX EVERYTHING ON WHEELS

Illinois Passes a Law Producing \$500,-000 From Vehicles.

Eighty thousand vehicles in Chicago will become liable to pay wheel tax just as soon as Governor Deneen signs the wheel tax law passed by the general assembly at Springfield. The governor has indicated that he will sign the bill

Under the operation of the act the tax will amount to \$500,000 each year. All of the money thus taised is required to be expended on the repairs of the streets. The tax applies to every vehicle on wheels that uses the city streets. Automobiles, wagons, drays, trucks, buggies, bicycles, and all of the wheel family, with the exception of baby carriages, will come in for a share of the payment. The tax is graduated according to the class of

Automobiles pay the largest tax, and the other vehicles will trail along in the assessment according to their value and kind.




