

PLAN POWER HOUSE

Officials Will Begin Actual Work on Plant as Soon as Walla Walla Grants Franchise.

Promoters of the Washington-Oregon Traction company are fast completing plans for actual construction work on the immense power house to be constructed on the upper Walla Walla river about eight miles above the present power house of the Northwest Gas and Electric company, says the Walla Walla Union.

All that is holding the work back now is the action of the city council in granting a franchise allowing the company to operate and maintain a power station in Walla Walla.

The franchise was introduced at the last meeting of the council Monday night, and read through its first reading. It was then referred to the council as a whole, to be acted upon finally at an adjourned meeting to be held next Tuesday night. That the franchise will be granted seems to be the general opinion of those who were present at the last meeting of the council and held arguments, made before that body.

Realizing that such a power house situated in close proximity to this city will revolutionize the lighting and power problem, which is now such an important factor in the city's affairs, it can hardly be doubted that favorable action will be taken by the council when that body meets to act on the proposition finally.

The Washington-Oregon Traction company is a concern being promoted by local men who are among the most substantial business promoters in the city. They have been working on a sewer plant, and subsequently an electric railroad, for several months and are just now getting into a position where actual work can be started.

The site for the new power house is said to be one of the most advantageous places on the Walla Walla river,

where an immense and tremendous fall can be maintained at a comparatively small cost.

Baker's Mayor Determined to Stop Incendiary Fires.

Following a series of incendiary fires that has struck terror to the entire 10,000 population of Baker City, Mayor Johns has issued the following proclamation:

"To the officers and people of Baker City: Believing that the many recent fires are of incendiary origin, and all such officers and good citizens are hereby instructed to shoot on the spot any person caught setting fire to any building. The property of this city must and shall be protected."

There are special patrolmen employed, and a great effort is being made to locate or capture the firebugs.

Thursday night there were three fires, one the old Faulk residence, unoccupied, but an historical old building. The loss was about \$5,000.

A few minutes later two barns were burned, and almost immediately after the old creamery property went up in smoke. Wednesday and Wednesday night there were three more fires of incendiary origin.

La Grande Improves.

La Grande will spend \$160,000 for a water and sewer system. The bonds were voted over a year ago, and have recently been sold in Chicago. The water will be secured from a pure, adequate mountain stream, at a point 17 miles from the city, and will be brought in an immense flume to a reservoir and will be sufficient for many years to come. Surplus flow will be used to operate a modern, complete sewer system. There will be water enough for fire-fighting purposes and also for power for electric lighting, and for commercial purposes, so that the city will get revenue not only from water consumers, but from power consumers. It will run its own lighting plant also.
