now is the action of the city conneil in granting a franchise allowing the company to operate and maintain a power station in Walla Walla.

water and sewer system. The bonds were voted over a year ago, and have recently been sold in Chicago. The water will be secured from a pure, adequate mountain stream, at a point 17 miles from the city, and will be brought in an immense flume to a reservoir and will be sufficient for many years to come. Surplus flow will be used to operate a modern, complete sewer system. There will be water enough for firefightug purposes and also for power for electric lighting, and for commercial purposes, so that the city will get revenue not only from water consumers, but from power consumers.
