

**Famous Golf Players  
Play at Walla Walla**

Walla Walla.—Arrangements have been completed here for an 18-hole exhibition match on Tuesday, August 21, at 2 o'clock P. M. with Archie Compston and Audrey Boomer, famous British golfing stars. The exhibition holes are to be played on the course of the Walla Walla Country Club, which is sponsoring the appearance of the two stars.

Compston, for several years a moderately well-known links artist, leaped into international fame almost over night when he handed Walter Hagen the worst drubbing ever given any professional of that caliber in match play. They ended what was to have been a 72-hole match, 18 up and 17 to go, in Compston's favor.

Boomer is recognized as one of the leading distance drivers in international golf today and as such is expected to be the center of attention for those who are always seeking longer flights for their drivers.

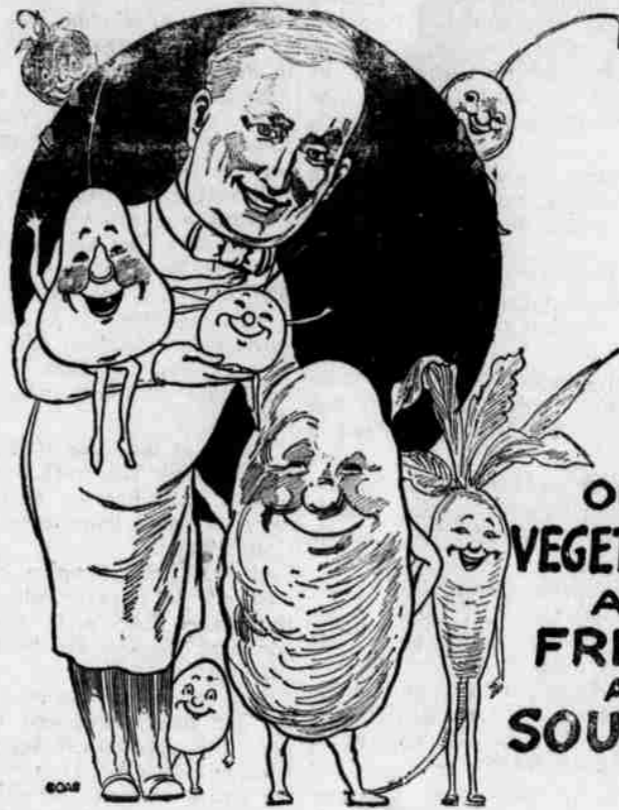
