SAFEGUARDING OUR RIGHTS AND LIBERTIES

No man has ever stated the fundamental principles of our theory of government or the ideals of its founders in clearer language than President-elect Herbert Hoover. His words lift themselves above partisan politics and lay down fundamentals which every American citizen should read and study from the standpoint of their bearing on his daily life. In his New York speech, Mr. Hoover said in part:

"Bureaucracy is ever desirous of spreading its influence and its power. You cannot extend the mastery of the Government over the daily working life of a people without at the same time making it the master of the people's souls and thoughts. Every expansion of Government in order to protect itself from the political consequences of its errors without peace to greater and greater strong. control of the nation's press and platform. Free speech does not live many hours after free industry and free commerce die.

"It is a false liberalism that interprets itself into the Government operation of commercial business. Every step of bureauratizing of the business of 'our country poisons the very roots of liberalism-that is, political equality, free speech, free assembly, free press and equality of opportunity. It is the road not to more liberty but to less liberty. Liberalism should be found not striving to spread bureaucracy but striving to set bounds to it. True liberalism seeks all legitimate freedom, first in the confident belief that without such freedom the pursuit of other blessings and benefits is vain. That belief is the foundation of all American progress, political as well as economic."
