to furnish this service for nothing, his bill should be paid. That was a new thought to the council but they thought best to have additional authority before acting upon his advice.

Members of the council realize that the town has received the articles for which these warrants were drawn and hence have no desire to escape their payment, but do not want to become personally liable for the amounts involved. They have urged the holders of the warrants to bring suit against the town for the sums involved, but the holders of the warrants show no inclination to solve the matter in this manner.

Between thoughts the council paid bills as noted below and instructed the recorder to write to the water superintendent at Portland for information regarding a cheaper meter in use there, that the use of meters may be extended here.

The water bill was \$348.60; lights, \$31; recorder's salary \$10 and Ruth Cady was paid \$5 for reading meters. A bill of \$64.90 was rendered by P. H. Vandehey for the following items: installing water at Vandehey residence 7.93; two taps at Masters residence. 38.36; installing meter at Beydler residence. 1.00; repairing leak near L. Reghetto residence. 1.50; installing water at H. R. Nelson residence. 8.91; lowering pipe and changing cocks on Hamilton street. 7.20. The labor charge is 60 cents an hour. This bill and R. L. Tucker's bill for \$4.05 for lumber for water boxes were ordered paid. Warrants on the general fund were ordered indorsed "Not paid for want of funds."
