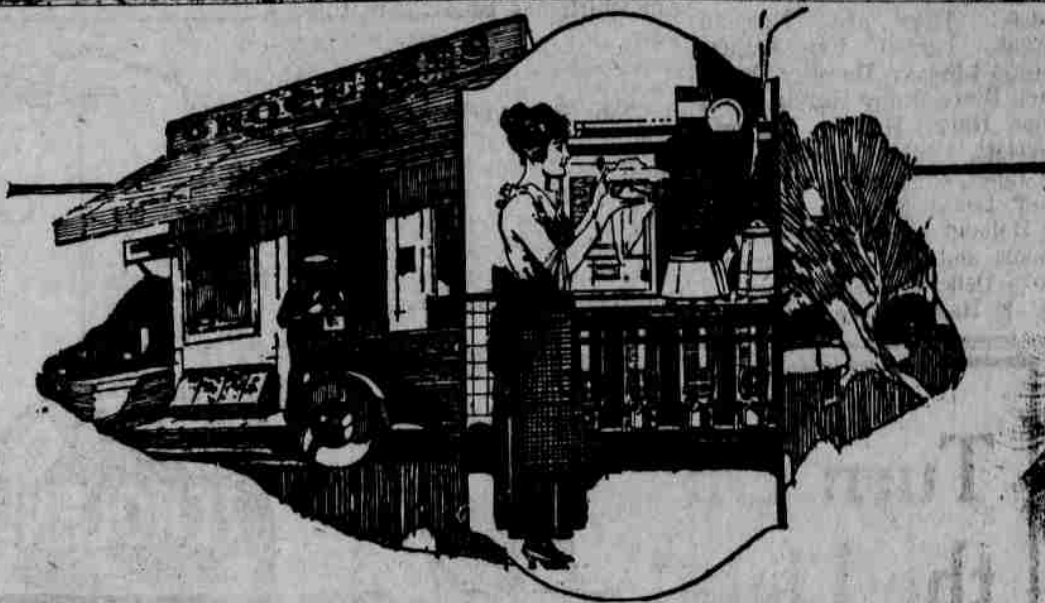


### Smallpox at Tigard.
