NIELS JENSEN

Niels Jensen was born in Copenha-
gen, Denmark, Feb. 8th, 1840, and
passed away at his residence in
Whitford, Oregon, Sunday afternoon
at 1:30, aged 79 years, 4 months and
14 days.

As a young man he served in Den-
mark's army in one of Europe's many
wars, when Germany compelled Den-
mark to give up Schleswig-Holstein
in October, 1864. The family have
some medals he received for service
in this war.

When 33 years of age (1873) he
left Denmark for America, going to
St. Paul, Minnesota, from there he
came to Oakland, California, where
he and Mrs. Jensen were married in
1882. In May, the following year,

they moved to the present home in
Whitford, Oregon.

Mr. Jensen had been a professing
Christian for years, being a member
of the Methodist Church.

He leaves to mourn his loss his
wife, and daughter, Mrs. M. Turn-
er, of Portland, and three grandchil-
dren.
