COUNTY AGENT NOTES.

Onion Growers to Fight Mildew

Despite the fact that there has been practically no mildew in the onion fields in this county for the past two seasons, weather conditions this year would indicate that it will be a wise policy to be in a position to combat it should the disease appear.

The onion growers got together last year to combat this disease and this organization, headed by J. C. Leedy, is again planning to carry on tests for the control of this disease. Thus far it has been difficult to obtain a spray that would stick to the pipes, but in trials on Mr. Leedy's farm it has been found that the addition of 1 per cent of dissolute oil works very satisfactorily and this method will be used this year.

Farm Bureau and County Court to Eradicate Canadian Thistle

Plans are under way for the complete eradication of Canada Thistle in Washington County. The seriousness of this weed pest was not recognized in earlier days and as a consequence there are areas now in the county which make farming difficult and unprofitable.

On account of the seriousness of this condition the Farm Bureau desires the co-operation of every farmer in the county in destroying these weeds on the premises and to report to the County Agent fields in which thistles have not been cut down. The County Court is co-operating in the proposition and are authorized by the last legislature to appoint persons to cut down thistles on farms where this has been neglected, the cost for which will be charged against the land. The seriousness of this weed pest lies in the fact that it not only spreads rapidly by seed which is spread by winds and also by flood water, but it also spreads from the root making it possible for the plant to spread many feet from these underground root stems.

The most satisfactory method of treatment is to cut and burn just prior to blooming, then practice clean cultivation for the rest of the season until controlled. For small areas covering with tar paper has been recommended, care being exercised that seams are lapped and that edges be weighed down.

GASOLINE BOILING POINTS TELL THE STORY.

Contrary to the opinion held by a great many people, the real value of gasoline is not shown by the old-fashioned gravity test. This test tells nothing about the vaporizing and combustive qualities of the fuel, as has been pointed out by the National Bureau of Standards at Washington. Only the boiling point test is really efficient.

Boiling points, of course, mean exactly what the words say. That is, they are points on the thermometer at which a liquid will begin to boil. For a cold engine to start quickly the gasoline must vaporize at a low temperature. To get quick and smooth acceleration somewhat higher boiling points are necessary and for full power and long mileage the fuel must have still higher boiling points.

High quality gasoline must have a complete and continuous chain of boiling points, ranging

from the low to the high. Combustion starts with the lowest and flashes on through the uniform chain from low to high with the result that there is full-powered, instantaneous combustion. Eliminate one link and the full power chain is broken. The famous Red Crown gasoline has the complete power chain.

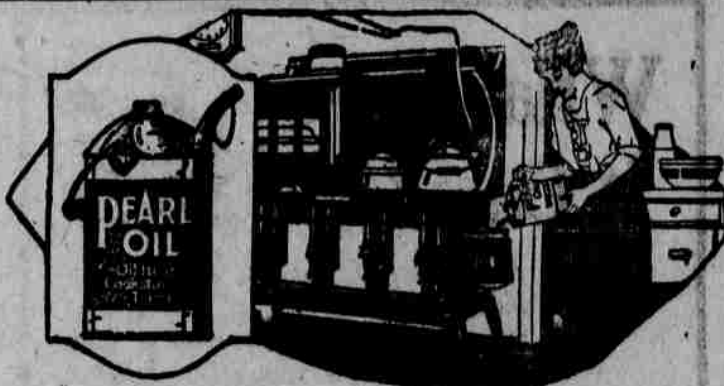
