Your War Savings Certificate, the certificate on which you stick your War Savings Stamps, can be registered at any postal station or postoffice, and such registration is free insurance for War Savings Stamps against fire and theft. The certificates may be registered in two names, or in the name of a beneficiary. If registered, the Government will reimburse you for the full value of your Stamps in case they are lost or destroyed. There is no charge for this insurance service.
