A grower of Netted Gem potatoca, near Redmand, has two fields. Bothster on new ground, both are irrigated and both are planted at a similar manner.

What is the difference then? One field was planted to be large potatocs, the other to the small potatoes from the lot.

On inspecting tham for cortification, August 16, the potatoes from from large seed showed 6 per centificatively dwarf. The small seed showed 20 per cent. disease and the plants were harder hit.

The two fields do not even lock smaller—yet many people buy such seed and plant it.


