Only two persons were placed in nomination, Major Lucas of Condon, and Lieut. Col. Thompson of The Dalles. The vote stood as follows:

For Lucas—A Co. 1; C Co. 3; E Co. 3; F Co. 2; G Co. 2; I Co. 3; total 14.

For Thompson—A Co. 2; B Co. 3; D Co. 3; total 8.

The vote of K Co., of La Grande did not reach there in time, but it was in favor of Maj. Lucas. The representatives from Baker City, Condon, Fossil and Joseph did not attend but sent in their votes.
