M. in honor of the first anniversary of the adoption of the Democratic County Convention, which will be held in Condon, Oregon, on Saturday, March 21, 1900, at 10 o'clock A. M. for the purpose of nominating candidates for county offices, and to elect three delegates to the Democratic State Convention.
