TO-DAY THE

NATION MOURNS.

William McKinley, the twenty-fifth President of the United States, and the third martyred Chief Executive, died at 2:15 a. m., Saturday, September 14, 1901, from the effect of an assassin's bullet, and is to-day being laid to rest at his old home at Canton, Ohio.

He was loved as a personally pure, clean man and citizen, respected as an honorable statesman and held in high esteem as a just ruler.

President Roosevelt and Governor Geer have each issued proclamations setting aside to-day as a day of National mourning.

To-day the Nation mourns.

Resolutions of Respect.

At a meeting of the members of the bar of this district held at this place Monday morning to take appropriate action regarding the death of President McKinley, the following resolutions were adopted:

WHEREAS: The death of President McKinley is a national calamity, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That in the death of the president the Nation has lost one of its ablest, most efficient, patriotic and conservative presidents; one whose private life and character challenged the admiration and respect of the civilized world and who was one of the grandest types of American manhood history records; one whose public life and character is worthy of emulation of the youth of the land.

RESOLVED: That we deplore and denounce the act of the assassin in shooting down the head of the nation in this land of universal freedom where the remedy for every grievance, real or imaginary, may be had by resort to the ballot.

RESOLVED: That out of respect to the memory of our president we ask the Court to adjourn for such time as to the Court may seem meet and proper, and that these resolutions be spread upon the journal.

Upon the convening of Court, at 10 A. M. the resolutions were presented to the Court. Addresses were made by S. A. D. Garley Esq., who presented the resolutions, H. S. Wilson Esq. and Hon. A. S. Bennett, of the bar, and Judge Bradshaw also spoke briefly from the bench.

It was then ordered that the resolutions be spread upon the journal of the court and that the court should stand adjourned until 7:30 P. M. as a mark of respect to the memory of the late chief magistrate.

Patriotic Midway.

In a letter to Gov. Geer, describing the scenes at Buffalo at the time of the shooting of President McKinley, Mr. Dyck, in charge of the Oregon Exhibit says: "Then the strangest thing happened, which I am still unable to understand. As soon as I learned of the tragedy I went at once to the superintendent of this building to have it closed out of respect to the President, but he did not wish to take the responsibility, and I had him 'phone to the Director-General, Mr. Buchanan, but he said it might create a disturbance, so everything went on as if nothing had happened. The thousands of people came and went, sightseeing; the fakers cried their wares, and people were buying souvenirs. The only people who did take cognizance of it, and it must be said to their credit, are those of the much misrepresented 'Midway.' As soon as they learned of it, all shows were closed promptly and the noisiest place on earth became as quiet as a graveyard. I am completely unimpressed this morning, everything goes on as usual."

SCENES OF SPLENDOR.

Portland Carnival's Brilliant Array of Attraction.
