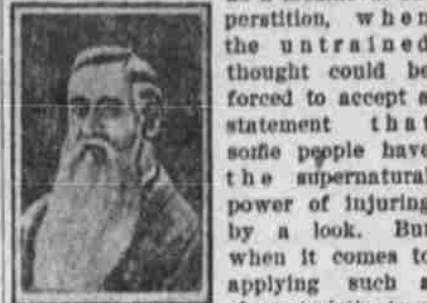

SAYS HE HAS THE "EVIL EYE"

Ridiculous Story Applied to Sir Edmund Monson.

How ridiculous it sounds to be talking of "the evil eye" in this enlightened generation! That was all right as a medieval superstition, when the untrained thought could be forced to accept a statement that some people have the supernatural power of injuring by a look. But when it comes to applying such a characteristic to a man high in diplomatic life in this era of widespread intelligence, it seems absurd. And yet the story has gone out from Paris that the recall of Sir Edmund Monson, the British ambassador, is due to the common belief that he has "the evil eye."



Strange stories and odd coincidences are cited as proof of the possession by this experienced diplomat of that optical influence so much dreaded in the middle ages.

Nine years ago Monson was sent to Paris. Prior to that he had been in Belgium. While he was there many of the misfortunes of that royal family occurred. The Queen's unhappiness was well known. Her eldest daughter, Princess Stephanie, lost her husband, Crown Prince Rudolph, under tragic circumstances. Her second daughter, Louise, was locked up in an insane asylum. From Austria, Greece and other countries where Monson has served come similar stories through which the superstition is interwoven. In Paris his fellow diplomats have fought shy of him and social campaigns have been curtailed from fear of his alleged malevolent optical influence. General Porter and he have been barely able to observe diplomatic decorum. Archbishop Lorenzelli, the Vatican representative and one of the ablest speakers in Europe, once broke down under the steady gaze of the Englishman. The Italian embassy are in a continual state of perturbation when he is around.

These stories are widely circulated. The truth of the matter undoubtedly is that there is that in Monson's personality and manner which causes embarrassment and discomfort to those in his presence. An overbearing disposition would have the same effect as the evil eye, so called. The strangest thing about the whole affair is that a fiction of the middle ages could be successfully applied in this day. There is no doubt that Paris believes in the "evil eye" story.

A GIRL'S NATURE.

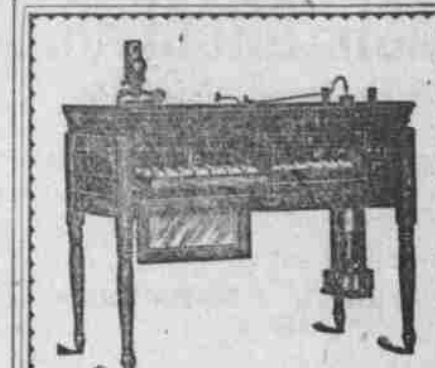
