Jonathan Bourne has been elected U. S. Senator by the popular vote of the people and the state legislature will ratify the election next January. The election of Mr. Bourne is a decided victory for the friends of the primary law and we have no hesitancy in making the prophecy that many republicans who believed they had good reasons for voting against Mr. Bourne, will live to see the day when they will be proud of the junior Senator from Oregon.

The editor of the GLOBE has been criticised by certain republicans(?) for supporting Jonathan Bourne. We have no apology to make to these self-styled republicans. Had we believed the malicious campaign lies that were industriously peddled in Gilliam and other counties by a band of human sheep who have at all times allowed their political boss to do their thinking for them, we should have opposed the candidacy of Mr. Bourne as strongly as we supported him. Our individuality is worth more to us than the patronage of a political boss and his retinue of servants and we don't care who knows it.

It has been evident for some time that the Dalles political bosses were in the plot to defeat Bourne and Withycombe, and the voting Monday showed the effects of their work among the faithful—Hood River Glacier.
