Sealed bids will be received by The Mayor and Council of the City of Condon, Oregon, for the construction of a ditch from the city well at Hay Creek to the city reservoir. Said ditch is to be two feet deep and two feet wide at the top with a bottom one foot in width. By agreement with the property owners through whose premises the ditch is to run, all the top soil is to be thrown on one side of the excavation and the bottom foot or more on the other side of the same. Bids will be received for the construction of the entire ditch, or it may be sub-divided and a bid made on any part. 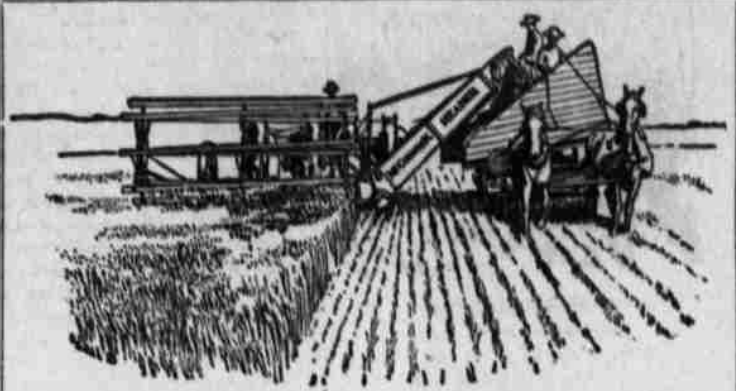
