The American Chamber of Commerce of Paris gave its customary Fourth of July banquet. The American colony at Berlin picnicked at Grunau, a beautiful suburb of that city. At Rio Janario a great reception was held aboard the U. S. Cruiser, St. Louis the same day. Thus it will be seen that Uncle Sam has become an International as well as a National character, and that our own people as well as the people of other countries are being distributed over the face of the civilized globe and are holding their own among the greatest wherever they go.

The Department of Justice intends breaking up unlawful trusts in this country. This will be done in various ways according to the various conditions met with. Receivers will be appointed where possible to take over and sell the plants of the combinations found guilty of violating the anti-trust law; injunctions will be issued for the dissolution of illegal combinations for the restraint of trade; that contracts made for such purpose be declared null and void when made; that such conspiracies will be prosecuted criminally and criminal sentences will be carried out the same as for infractions of other laws. The tobacco and powder trusts are to be proceeded against along these lines. Many prosecutions are now under way and many victories have already been scored by the Department and many more will follow. We have plenty of good laws and plenty of 'backbone' in the present administration at Washington to enforce them.

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
