

BUSINESS LOCALS

It is significant that Senator Bowerman, who is known to have been in close touch with State Treasurer Steel (at present one of his bondsmen) and the Ross bank, through the State Treasurer, favored and voted uniformly for everything that Mr. Steel and the Trust Company desired, although it is very plain that every one of these measures (with the possible exception of the Review bill whose defeat, however, meant perhaps a half a million dollars to the bank, worked for by the bank, was directly antagonistic to the welfare of the general public, and in like proportion favorable to the bank. No Senator who voted for the Ross bills and amendments should ever be allowed to enter the Senate again, for those votes proved them to be recreant to their trust as servants of the people of Oregon. Is it any wonder that the Oregonian asks: "Were the members of the Legislature of 1907 making laws for the people or for the Title Guarantee and Trust Company? They drew their salaries from the State and not from the Trust Company. But the Trust Company has cause for congratulations when the "sure thing" was enacted."

Voters, the question is now up to you: Will you send "joiners," with his record which shows him to have been all the secret enemy of the people he was elected to represent, back to the Senate; or will you elect Judge Geo. B. Bourhill, a man whose worst enemy in the entire district has to admit is a clean, able, conscientious man; a man who has followed the plow and has worked his way up to being one of the leading business men of his county; a man whose interests lie with the plain people, of whom he is one; and who will not spend his time in the Legislature scheming to help a lot of hoodlums loot the school fund, or to foist incompetent officials upon an unwilling people? Senator Bowerman does not rely upon his past record for re-election, but on the strength of the "machine" he and his henchmen have built up throughout the district. We believe for our part, that there are enough men in the Republican party who do their own thinking, and who will not allow a Senator to choose their names for them, and when a vote is counted after the primaries, Judge Geo. B. Bourhill of Sherman county will be the Republican party's choice for Joint Senator from this district.

Wm. J. Mariner, candidate for Representative, is a man of sterling character, one who cannot be influenced by petty political deals, one who will always represent the people, and look after their interests as his work in the Legislature. He is the man to send to the Legislature. The PEOPLE'S interests will be safe in his hands.

Judge Geo. B. Bourhill spent several days in Condon this week, meeting the people who were waiting to send him to the Legislature. Mr. Bourhill is a man of sterling qualities, who will be elected as the choice of the people on his own merits.
