T. D. Sweetin the efficient marshal of Arlington arrived in Condon Monday evening with a prisoner for the county bastille. The young fellow, whose name is Arthur A. Reed, worked for Geo. Williams near Clem during last spring. Last week on finding some returned checks belonging to Mr. Williams and also some blank checks he forged Mr. Williams name to the extent of \$97.50 and on Sunday evening was arrested by Marshal Sweetin in Arlington while at the depot waiting for a train. He was given a preliminary hearing on Monday morning before Justice Collins and was bound over to the Circuit Court under \$1500 bond which not being forthcoming he was lodged in the county jail. When arrested he had \$71. of the money in his pocket and was wearing a new suit of clothes and had a new suitcase which he had purchased with the remainder.

**Gipsies are Fined.**

From the Fossil Journal is learned what happened to the Gipsies who camped in Condon last week and who robbed a number of people between this city and Fossil.—Frank Golden, who was robbed of \$6.50 and Wm. Taylor who was also robbed of \$10.75, swore out warrants for the arrests of the two gipsy women who took their money, and Sheriff Kelsay went to Condon after the culprits and brought them back to Fossil on Friday where they pleaded guilty and were fined \$25 and costs by Justice E. F. Johnson, amounting to \$100. Golden and Taylor got their money back through Justice Johnson but a large number of other victims, who made no official complaint, are out from one to several dollars each. Geo. Jones of Lost Valley and John Thomas of Fossil engaged in a catch-as-catch-can scuffle with the gipsy women, with the result that Jones got back his twenty dollars and Thomas got back five dollars of the \$7.25 the woman had abstracted from his orny palm.
