Will be held Court House on May 23rd - Lecture to be illustrated.

As a result of the interest in good roads work for which so much is being accomplished in the State by the State Threshers' Association, the office of Public Roads U. S. Department of Agriculture recently tendered Secretary Bates, through Senator Bourne, a series of illustrated lectures and this county has been favored with one of the dates, May 23.

This lecture will be given at the Court House, is free and every farmer, stockman and business man is invited to be present. The illustrated lecture will be in charge of Maurice O. Eldridge, Assistant Chief of Road management, office of Public Roads, Washington, D. C.

Mr. Eldridge has a most pleasing personality and is the equal of any good roads lecturer in the United States. He has charge of the exhibit of the office of Public Roads at the Alaskan-Yukon-Pacific Exposition where he made many friends among the good road enthusiasts of the Pacific Northwest. They all say, however, that there is nothing awe-inspiring about the astral body and it will be necessary for it to do some rapid traveling if it succeeds in getting close enough to the earth to make anything like the big show promised by the scientists during the past several months. At present the comet itself looks like a large star and the tail extending southward appears to be about 75 feet in length. Those who are willing to arise about 3 o'clock should be able to obtain a fairly good view of the visitor from out the region of immeasurable space. It will be seen low down near the horizon and just a little north of east.
