ATTENTION

Notice is hereby given that the County Superintendent of Gilliam County will hold a special examination of applicants for temporary county certificates, in Condor on September 7th and 8th.

Following is the law regarding issuing same.

A temporary county certificate may be issued by the County Superintendent in case of necessity, valid only in the county where issued until the next regular public examination held by the county superintendent for such county, to a holder of a certificate valid in any other state, when the applicant for the same shall present satisfactory testimonials of good character and success as a teacher; but no permit shall be issued to any person not holding a valid certificate as herein set forth, except on a written examination equivalent to that required for a one-year State certificate except in Oregon school law. Only one temporary certificate shall be issued to any applicant within the state within a period of three years and issuance of same shall be immediately reported to the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Registers and Receivers of U. S. Land offices have been notified that after the first of next Dec. all those making proof on homesteads must produce absolute proof of residence for the full period of five years before a patent can be issued thereon.
