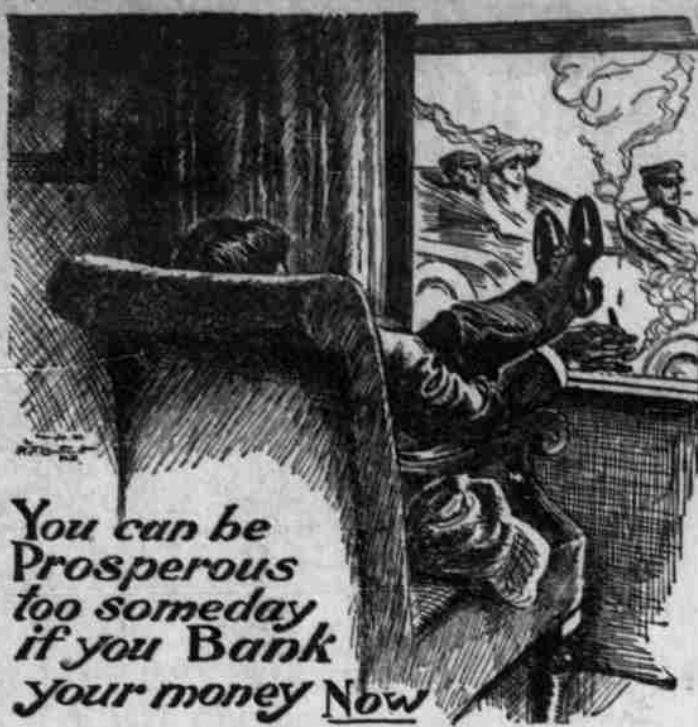

Any person allowing Russian thistles, Canada thistles, Jim Hill mustard or silver salt bush to grow upon his land is subject to a fine. It is the owners duty to see that these weeds are removed. It is also the duty of each road supervisor to ascertain whether or not there are any of these weeds in his district and if he finds any he must notify the owner of the property to remove them before the seed has formed. Should the owner refuse to remove the weeds the supervisor can do so and the expenses become a lien on the land. Several farmers who make efforts to keep their farms clean of such weeds have complained many times of those who do not. This law should be enforced vigorously.
