Official Report of Proceedings of the County Court

At a regular term of the County Court of Oregon for Gilliam county held at the Court House in Condon, Oregon, on March 6th, 1918, when were present: G. W. Farman, County Judge, John W. Maidment, Commissioner, Sherman Wade, Commissioner, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the petition of E. C. Maddock et al for a county road (road runs east from City of Arlington)—Report of the road viewers read as provided by law, and road ordered opened.

In the matter of the petition of H. A. Stewart et al for a county road—Petition etc approved and regular board of county road viewers ordered to meet and view said road as provided by law on March 15, 1918.

In the matter of the petition of Alma Lauder for a gateway—regular board of county road viewers ordered to meet and view said gateway March 18, 1918, and that notice be given W. H. Speece and Jacob Larch through whose lands the road as proposed will pass.

In the matter of the petition of Mrs. W. J. Russell et al for a county road, down 30-Mile creek from the Trail Fork road—It appearing to the court that there are a greater number of remonstrators on the remonstrance than there are names on the petition, the petition dismissed.

In the matter of the statement from the County Clerk showing the bounties paid—Statement approved.

In the matter of the Transfer of funds—Ordered that \$15,000 be transferred from the County General Fund to the County Road Fund, and that the sum of \$466.09, appropriated by the State of Oregon for fair purposes for the year 1917, be transferred to the County Road Fund, as provided by law.

In the matter of apportionment of apportionment of funds for the various road districts of Gilliam county—Sum of \$900 set aside for each road district, to be spent under the direction of the court.

In the matter of the appointment of patrolmen—The following appointed: District No. 4, George Crum; No. 5, H. A. Stewart; No. 6, Leslie Wing; No. 7, Clarence Edwards; No. 8, C. R. Peugh; No. 9, none appointed; No. 10, J. G. Boyer; No. 11, A. Neel; No. 12, George Crum; No. 13, C. R. Peugh; No. 14, Josh Hardie.

In the matter of fixing the wages for men and teams for county road work—The following schedule ordered: Teams \$3 per day; patrolmen \$3.25; grademen \$2.25; common labor \$3; grader driver \$3.

In the matter of the auditing and allowing claims against Gilliam county, Oregon—The following allowed and ordered paid:
