### "Kaiser" Jackson Is Inconsistent

"Somewhat amusing is the position of outraged virtue assumed by Kaiser C.S. Jackson, high priest of the single tax in Oregon, who accuses the country newspapers of abusing him because of the measures he has initiated to do away with the publication of the delinquent tax list and to decrease the rate for legal publications," says the Cottage Grove Sentinel. This paper goes on to state that its editor, who is secretary of the Willamette Valley Editorial Association, wrote Mr. Jackson on February 26 asking him to appear before the organization for the express purpose of discussing the merits of his proposed measures. Kaiser Jackson haughtily ignored this letter and has never given a reason for not wishing to meet the country newspaper men face to face. The most plausible explanation is that Kaiser Jackson is too cowardly to adopt the suggestion, knowing that he would be badly worsted because of having almost no argument for his side of the case but his charge of abuse at this time comes with mighty bad grace. Editor Bede says that at the legislative session at which the present bill was passed Jackson was represented by his man Friday, Attorney Hagood, and he admitted that the bill was a good one and a wise piece

of legislation. "If you will allow our delinquent tax bill to go through without a fight, I will go, before the committee which is considering your bill and tell them it is one of the best pieces of legislation ever proposed to a legislature" are the words Bede credits Hagood with using. At the committee meeting Bede asked Hagood if he had made the statement quoted above. Evidently thinking that a trade was in sight Hagood admitted the fact. Now this law, which Jackson's representative admitted to be one of the best pieces of legislation ever proposed to a legislature, is held up to ridicule by the man who once endorsed it. What is the reason for such inconsistency?

## UNITED WAR FUND SURE TO BE NEEDED

Even End of Hostilities Would Not Change This.

Though the war should cease immediately it is said that every cent of the \$170,500,000 sought in the United War Work campaign in the United States, for the seven approved organizations ministering to the American fighters, will be needed just the same.

This is the word of leaders of the fund-raising campaign and their explanation is easily comprehended. In the first place, it has been officially estimated that 18 months to two years must elapse before all the American boys can be returned from foreign soil. There are the men of many other countries to be transported home when the war ends, so the number of boats for use of the Yankees will be limited. Then there is also the fact that thousands must remain so long as the great properties and stores of the United States have not been disposed of or returned.

Immediate cessation of war activities in Europe would plainly create grave problems connected with the care of the men. Remove the great motive which actuates every man at the front today and throw him into dull inactivity, with nothing much to do but await his chance to return to home and loved ones, and the work of keeping him cheerful increases in magnitude. The soldier welfare organizations foresee all phases of this grave contingency. They foresee how great would be the need for reading matter, entertainments, amusements, recreation and the cheery personal touch.
