

Spring raffle debuts at CB History Center and Museum

For the first time ever, the Cannon Beach History Center and Museum is having a Spring Raffle. The raffle has been made possible by Cannon Beach's Icefire Glassworks. The owners and artists have graciously donated a beautiful vase, a tantalizing swirl of yellows, blues, and deep reds and ombres. It's absolutely fabulous, but what isn't from the talented Jim Kingwell?

Kingwell was born and raised in Portland, Oregon. He attended Willamette University in Salem and Portland State University, majoring in ceramics with a focus in design and silicate chemistry. Since 1971, he began glass blowing when he partner built a hot glass studio on the Oregon coast, where they used recycled glass. In 1974, he began making glass from its raw ingredients. Kingwell moved Icefire Glassworks to McMinnville in 1977, and to the foothills of the Coast Range near Willamina in 1980. In 1991, he founded the studio in Cannon Beach where he still creates today. If you have never been, Icefire Glassworks is located in the old Van Vleet logging building at the corner of Gower Street and Hemlock. At Icefire Glassworks, visitors can watch as glass artists Jim Kingwell and Suzanne Kindland create vessels with dramatic colors. They want to educate their audience while at the same time getting some real work done.

Tickets are available at the museum or through the museum's online gift shop. For just \$5, a unique piece of artwork created by a local artist could be yours! The drawing will take place at the Cannon Beach History Center and Museum on Friday, May 29 at the museum's Acoustic Season Finale.

The season finale closes out with Oregon favorite Beth Willis and Todd Chatalas. Willis was honored at the Portland Music Awards in 2012 with the award for Best

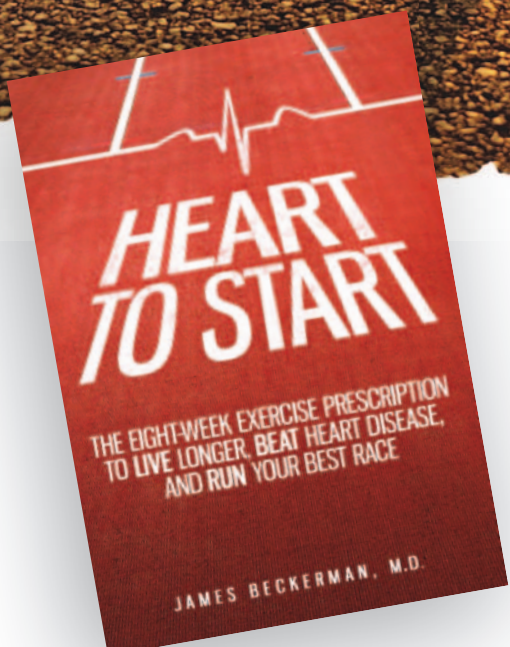
