The event helps fund the nonprofit's Regional Food Bank, a central clearinghouse for food donations on the North Coast.

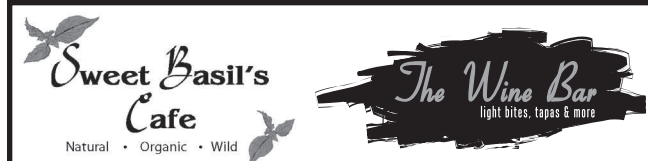
