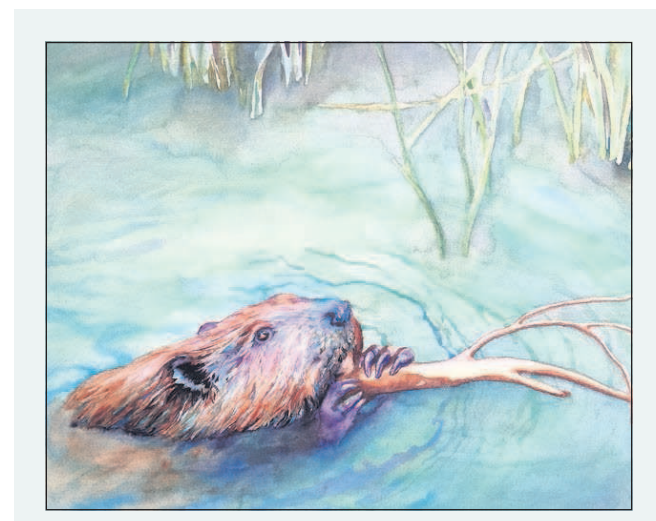

A celebration of beavers

To celebrate beavers and their contribution to the ecology of the North Coast, the Wetlands Conservancy and Lower Nehalem Watershed Council have partnered with local businesses to host the Beaver Tales Art Exhibit and Sale in Nehalem. The exhibit opens on July 31 at the North County Recreation District in Nehalem, 36155 Ninth St. On Aug. 4, local naturalist and photographer Neal Maine will give a special presentation on beaver ecology at 6:30 p.m., followed by a reception and viewing of the works in the NCRD Art Gallery. The exhibit will be on display through Aug. 30. The exhibit will feature juried art for purchase, a portion of the sales will benefit the Wetlands Conservancy and Lower Nehalem Watershed Council. The traveling exhibit includes artwork of all kinds, from paintings to fiber, wood, stone, glass and ceramics. With regional and local artists displaying their work, this stop in Nehalem will bring together a multitude of styles.
