MANZANITA — Built in 1933, the Pine Grove Community House is listed in the National Register of Historic Places for the building's association with the founding of the city of Manzanita and its local government, community social events, and the gradual evolution of the town to a full-fledged community and center for coastal recreation.

Pine Grove represents the first civic project of the first residents of Manzanita who, with no early municipal government, formed their own community group to address the needs and management of their small town.
