John O'Hurley on stage in Cannon Beach

John O'Hurley, one of America's busiest and most versatile stars is heading to Cannon Beach in September.

O'Hurley is taking a weekend away from his starring role in "Chicago," the longest-running American musical in Broadway history, to perform his award-winning, one-man show, "A Man with Standards," at Coaster Theatre on Saturday, Sept. 8.

O'Hurley delights his audiences with the colorful stories and songs of his youth, as well as revisiting moments on "Seinfeld" and "Dancing With The Stars."

The show has received praise for his retrospective of music of the Great American Songbook, as told by him in the perspective of his eclectic life and career, and has been nominated by Broadway World for the Best Show award.

O'Hurley won a Screen Actors Guild Award for his work on "Seinfeld" with his unique portrayal of the wry

and witty "J. Peterman." He officially won Season 1 of "Dancing with the Stars" in a highly contested "Dance Off." He was named one of People magazine's, "Sexiest Men Alive."

O'Hurley is the regular host of "The National Dog Show presented by Purina," as well as the "Beverly Hills Dog Show."

He was also host of "Family Feud" and "To Tell The Truth."

His very recognizable voice can be heard as King Neptune on "SpongeBob Square Pants" and the mayor on Disney's hit "Phineas and Ferb."

On stages across the country, he is best known for his performances as King Arthur in Monty Python's "Spamalot" and his continuing portrayal of slick lawyer, Billy Flynn, in "Chicago," which earned him best actor status in the city of Chicago in 2011.
