

**Our Portland Letter.**

Portland, Oregon, Nov. 23, (Special):

Special short courses that are bound to be of great interest to many throughout the state are offered during the winter by the Oregon Agricultural College. These courses will commence January 4 and continue for a period of six weeks. There will also be a special short course covering a period of five days commencing Monday, Feb. 11, offered particularly for those who are unable to take the longer course. These short courses are of especial value to practical farmers, horticulturists and stockmen throughout the state.

Every department of the agricultural college will take part in these courses. Lectures and demonstrations will be given in the subjects of general agriculture, dairying, horticulture, mechanical arts, domestic science, forestry and commerce. Taught as these subjects will be by experts, with many object lessons of what is accomplished on the college farm, those who take the courses cannot fail to receive great benefit.


Valuable co-operation will be lent the college staff by practical men largely responsible for the success of large farms, orchards, dairies and stock ranches of the state. Exhibits in all these lines will be made and the railroads have agreed to carry the exhibits without charge. There are no entrance examinations required for these short courses. The only expenses will be for board and room, which will cost from \$3.50 to \$4.50 per week, and laboratory and registration fees that will amount to not more than \$3 in any one course. There will be no fees connected with the five days' course.

Oregon's chief city is going ahead as never before in its history. Portland is growing because the state at large is prosperous and is constantly increasing in wealth. Plans to beautify the city by following a comprehensive scheme of city building are now receiving a great deal of attention. Mayor Simon announces that during the coming year 90 miles of hard surface pavement will be put down, making the streets of the metropolis equal, if not superior, to any other city in the West. At present Portland has a total of 60 miles of hard surface pavements.

Apples grown in Washington and Oregon will grace the tables of European royalty this winter, through the plan of James J. Hill, the Great Northern magnate, who has ordered 100 boxes of the best apples displayed at the Spokane apple show. He has wired his Spokane agent to pay \$10 a box if necessary. He says he wants the apples for Christmas presents to the following: "Royal and titled heads of Europe holding stock in the Hill roads, the Queen of Denmark, the King of England, the Emperor of Germany, titled members of the British Parliament and German and Swedish personages of royal blood." Apples will be selected from fruit grown along the Hill lines and from the Deschutes Valley.

A distinguished pioneer of the state was laid to rest during the past week. Joseph H. Lambert was widely known as the originator of the famous Lambert cherry and his services to advance the horticultural interests of the state were very valuable. He died at the advanced age of 83 years.


