VARIOUS SOURCES IN OREGON

Hood River is to have a free municipal swimming pool.

Construction of jetties on the Siuslaw will begin this season.

According to reports trains will be running to Coos Bay by Janury next.

Ground has been broken for the new \$50,000 building at Monmouth normal school.

The residence of J. Shoperts at Oredale, near Willamina, was burned to the ground last Satur- he does not prosecute violations of day in the absence of the family. The family bedding and the contents of one room were saved. The house and contents were insured for \$700.

County Fruit Inspector D. W Rumbaugh while at Lebannon Saturday reported several more cases of the much dreaded fire blight in orchards near that place. He says the only way to eradicate the disease is to cut and burn every tree found to be infected.

Approximately 80,000 gallons of crude pretroleum have been spread over 50 miles of Polk county roads this season, outside of the incorporated cities. The oiled strip varies from eight feet to eighteen feet, and Polk county now claims the best summer roads in the state.

The announcement has been made by District Attorney Ringo, of Salem, that he will retry the case of the State vs. Clarence Bursell, charged with murdering Charles Zimmerman, of Silverton, on August 2. After deliberating for 27 hours, the jury in the case reported Saturday to Circuit Judge Kelly that it was unable to agree, and was discharged. It is reported that seven were for acquittal and five for conviction on the first ballot, and that during the jury's deliberation there was no change in the vote.

A firebug is believed to be operating in the vicinity of Lincoln, a farming community in the northeastern part of Polk county. Two weeks ago the only store there was completely detroyed by a mysterious fire about midnight, while early Thursday morning of last week the two large warehouses there, having a capacity of 24,000 bushels of grain, were burned to the ground. The cause of the fire is unknown. There was no grain in the buildings at the time, as the new crop had not yet been harvested.

The wagon road to Alsea connecting Eugene with Florence will soon be completed.

Petitions asking for recall of Joseph K. Starr, district attorney for Wheeler county, have been presented for filing with Secretary of State Olcott. The petitions allege that he is "both corrupt and incompetent," and that he "indulges freely in strong drink, rendering him incompetent to attend to the duties of his office, and that the local option laws." Further, it is alleged that he does not enforce the laws alike on all persons, and that his inability makes his administration expensive.
