It is verydoubtful if any of those persons will be brought to account for the murder of the state's prisoner. Georgia is not a state which has a very high moral standard
Georgia as an investigator of lynch ings has never obtained a record for thoroughness.
There is no calamity ever befallen Georgia that will work as much real harm as this last diabolical act of a few of her blood-thirsty toughs. Like all other states Geoirga has her coterie of honorable, law-abiding citizens and just the same as all other states, and even cities and villages, where this lawabiding element does not predominate lawlessness thrives.
