Baker county papers are advocating the hard surfacing of roads.

The flax industry will bring 250 Belgium families to Marion county.

Prune drying is now at its high in the Willamette valley and the crop promises to equal expectations.

The limerock quarries south of Roseburg are to be operated in connection with the Oswego cement factory.

Construction work on the extension of the O. W. R. & N. railroad from Riverside to Dog Mountain, has begun, and a large crew will soon be at work.

Gust Olson, aged 68 years, was convicted in the justice court at Toledo last week of bootlegging among Indians. This was Olson's third or fourth conviction. He was fined \$200 and one month in jail.

Three machines of the auto stage line from Florence to Coos Bay narrowly escaped being washed into the breakers on the trip south Friday. One machine, full of traveling men, was hit by a wave that killed the engine and left them all stranded in the line of breakers. They got out, put husky shoulders to the four wheels and shoved the auto back upon the dry sand again.

A warrant was issued this week at Dallas at the instigation of the district attorney for the arrest of John Krebs charged with assault with a dangerous weapon, at the Molson hop yard near Derry. Krebs is said to have shot several times at Naomi Bowers, with whom he had had a lovers' quarrel the night previous. None of the bullets hit the woman, but one narrowly missed a small boy who was standing near. He has been bound over to the grand jury.

At an early hour Monday morning burglars entered the billard and pool hall of the N. A. Monroe company at Hood River, getting loot, merchandise and cash valued at over \$100. An entrance was made through a back window.

Dr. George Wall, one of the most prominent physicians of the state, was found in a dying condition Saturday at his apartments in Cottage Grove and although medical aid was summoned he died a few minutes later. Apoplexy was the cause.

Though there is but four feet of water on the bar at the mouth of Rogue river, the gasoline schooner *Rustler*, drawing 4½ to 6 feet of water, persists in coming and going as usual, the vessel being carried through by the engine and the action of the waves, which pick her up and bump her across.

W. G. Carroll, assistant United States engineer, who is superintending the Nehalem jetty, says the tramway of the structure has been completed and its erection has started. The entire jetty is expected to be finished by November 1. The preliminary work has begun on the construction of the north jetty at the entrance to Nehalem bay. The rock for it will be delivered at the same site as was that for the south jetty, and then towed on barges across the bay.
