If You Have a Good Thing Pass it Along.

Under this head we propose to inaugurate an exchange system of household helps and your favorite recipes. We believe you will be interested in this and ask your co-operation in making the Home Department of mutual helpfulness to the community.

Chocolate Nut Cake.

Three eggs, three-fourth cup each of brown and white sugar, three-fourth cup coffee and milk mixed, one cup ground walnuts, four tablespoons melted butter, two tablespoons ground chocolate or cocoa, one-half nutmeg, grated, two teaspoons baking powder, flour to make moderately stiff batter. Bake in layer cake tins and put together with boiled icing.

New Recipe for Boiled Icing.

One cup sugar, three tablespoons water, white of one egg. Place all in bowl of boiling water, or better still in double boiler and beat six minutes with Dover egg beater. Use any desired flavoring. If a little too firm add a few drops of hot water. Simply delicious.

Apple Fruit Cake Without Eggs.

One cup sugar, one-half cup shortening, one cup raisins, one teaspoon cinnamon, one-quarter teaspoon of cloves, one-half nutmeg, one and three-fourths cups flour, one cup applesauce with one teaspoon soda stirred in sauce the last thing.

To save the yolks of eggs, when the whites only are used, drops the yolks

into a tumbler of cold water, set in a cold place and they will keep fresh for several days.

If half a lemon is left over, place it on a plate and turn a tumbler over it; it will keep fresh much longer than if exposed to the air.

A soft cloth dipped in spirits of wine and rubbed on soiled leather will remove every spot.

When eggs are scarce and a recipe calls for more than one, use a tablespoonful of constarch in its place.

When making corn bread by any recipe, if one large cooked potato, hot or cold, is rubbed through a very large sieve into the batter, it greatly improves it, making it light and feathery.

In baking cakes, gems and other things which are apt to come out of the pan rough or torn on the bottom, try cooling the bottom of the pan quickly on a cloth that is soaked with cold water. The cakes will come out of the pans quickly and perfectly whole.

One-half teaspoon of soda and one teaspoon of cream of tartar are equal to two teaspoons of baking powder.
