Apple Pudding.

One-half cup of sugar, one-half cup milk, one egg, one heaping teaspoon baking powder, flour to make a soft batter. Butter a pudding pan and spread bottom thickly with apples cut in rather small pieces, sprinkle with cinnamon and pour batter over them and bake.

Pudding Sauce.

One small cup sugar, butter size of walnut, one and one-half tablespoons cornstarch. Set in a warm place until well blended together and stir while pouring in one cup of boiling water, add one teaspoon vanilla.

This is a simple easily made pudding and is universally liked.

Hermits.

Cream one-half cup butter, add gradually one cup granulated sugar and two eggs well beaten without separating, one teaspoon cinnamon, one-half teaspoon cloves, one-quarter nutmeg, grated, one-half teaspoon soda dissolved in a tablespoon water. Stir in one cup

seeded chopped raisins. Mix well and stir in carefully two and one-half cups flour that has been sifted with one heaping teaspoon baking powder. Drop by spoonful on baking sheet or they are nice baked in gem pans, allowing only a spoonful to each pan. A few nut meats added are very nice.

The little black specs that appear on silver articles that have been laid aside some time should be cleaned with a paste of whiting and olive oil. Then lightly polish with a piece of old silk. If the specs are very obstinate cover the article with the paste and allow it to remain for a considerable time. Wipe and polish with silk or a good soft piece of chamois and rouge.

Running several rows of fine machine stitching around the legs of stockings, particularly the thin ones, just below where the supporters are attached, will prevent a dropped stitch from running the full length of the stocking.
