## If You Have a Good Thing Pass it Along.

Under this head we propose to inaugurate an exchange system of household helps and your favorite recipes. We believe you will be interested in this and ask your co-operation in making the Home Department of mutual helpfulness to the community.

Mrs. Harry W. Thomas has favored us this week with some of her famous recipes.

### Buns.

One pint of soft bread sponge, one-third cup melted butter (or cottolene), one-half cup sugar, two eggs, pinch of salt. Flour to make stiff dough.

### Lemon Butter.

Three eggs well beaten, one cup sugar, one tablespoon butter, grated rind of half a lemon and a little of the juice. Boil in double boiler, stirring constantly until it thickens.

### Lemon Jelly Cake.

Two cups sugar, one-half cup of butter, one cup sweet milk, three eggs, two and a half teaspoons baking powder, three cups flour. Bake in four layers. Flavoring.

### Filling for Above Cake.

One cup powdered sugar, one-half cup butter, yolk of one egg,

one tablespoon cold coffee. Flavoring.

### Cocoanut Pies.

Eight eggs, two cups sugar, four cups milk, one cup cocoanut, one-half teaspoon lemon extract, pinch of salt and small lump of butter.

Tapioca Glue—Tapioca, soaked in water, makes a harmless, odorless and stainless glue. It is especially to be recommended for use by children.

Banishing Rust—To remove rust from a knife, plunge the blade into an onion and leave it there for an hour or so. Then polish it in the usual way.

To Prevent Scorch—Place salt in the oven under your baking tins, and the contents will not scorch on the bottom.
